Sawmill Report - Peter Field

The Sawmill has continued to evolve since the last AGM. In the window display both Jane and Jayne have done sterling work landscaping the O gauge circuit. Jane is also producing buildings to populate the landscape. The viaduct for the window O gauge is in and looks impressive. A start has been made to install some of Peter Davies old track in the window display, this will eventually continue through above the DCC layout.

The Peco loan layout finally arrived and is installed. Although we have some reliability issues it looks good.

Slowly, the new DCC O gauge layout is progressing, with 1/3rd the track laid. Hopefully, during the winter we will complete the track and connect electrics, meanwhile buildings and tunnel mouths are in progress at home.

The G scale layout continues to be reliable, and Trevor has brought in more buildings including a castle fitted above the tunnel, this now needs landscaping.

Thanks to Jayne and Murphy for their unstinting efforts in keeping the rails on all the layouts shiny and clean and the trains running. Joyce and Bob provide help anywhere it is needed including glueing, landscaping or helping with track laying.

David Brown of Liskeard has given us 3 new boat models which are on display in the main display cabinets.

Looking forward to the winter we hope to continue the DCC and window O gauge work. Laying track, electrification, and landscaping.
